

## Cookie Policy

To make our Website work properly, we sometimes place small data files called cookies on your device. Most big Websites do this too. Cookies are small text files or part of a file stored on your computer and containing personal information (such as a user identification code, customized preferences, or a record of web pages visited). The files are placed on your computer by Websites that you visit. They are used to make Websites work, or work more efficiently, as well as to provide information to the owners of the Website such as performance, security, etc. Some web browsers allow control of most cookies through the browser settings. You can control and/or delete cookies as you wish – for details, see links below. You can delete all cookies that are already on your computer and you can set most browsers to prevent them from being placed. If you do this, however, you may have to manually adjust some preferences every time you visit a Website and some services and functionalities may not work.

### Base Fundamentals Website use Cookies

Some of the cookies used by us in the Website are essential in order to make our Website usable by enabling basic functions like page navigation and access to secure areas of the Website. The Website cannot function properly without these cookies.

Some of the cookies used by us in the Website are used in order to collect information about how visitors use our Website, for instance which pages visitors go to most often. We use them to improve how our Website works.

Base Fundamentals is hosted on a Cloud Based Web Development (“CBWD”) platform. It's important to note that third-party services, such as Google Analytics or other applications offered through the CBWD Platform App Market, may be placing cookies or utilizing other tracking technologies through CBWD Platform services. Such third-parties services hosted on our Website may also collect and store information, as these are external services, Base Fundamentals have limited or no control over such information.

### Purposes for Using Cookies

The CBWD Platform and by proxy our Website uses cookies for many important reasons, such as:

- To provide a great experience for website visitors subscribers and customers.
- To identify our registered subscribers (users who registered to our Website).

- To monitor and analyze the performance, operation and effectiveness of the platform.
- To ensure the platform is secure and safe to use.

**Types of Cookies**

Cookies can be classified according to their type, duration and category. There are two main categories of cookies:

- First-party cookies: Cookies that the CBWD Platform places on our Website.
- Third-party cookies: Cookies that are placed and used by third parties.

**Duration**

- Session (transient) cookies: These cookies are erased when Website visitors close their browsers and are not used to collect information from their computers. They typically store information in the form of a session identification that does not personally identify the user.
- Persistent (permanent or stored) cookies: These cookies are stored on a Website visitor's hard drive until they expire (at a set expiration date) or until they are deleted. These cookies are used to collect identifying information about the user, such as web surfing behavior or user preferences for a specific Website.

**Category:**

- Strictly necessary cookies: These are the cookies that let our Visitors browse through our Website. They are also necessary for security reasons.
- Functional cookies: These cookies "remember" registered Visitors/customers in order to improve their user experience.

The table below states which cookies we may place on our Websites:
